

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF TUNJA OF
THE REPUBLIC OF COLOMBIA AND VISANG EDUCATION OF REPUBLIC OF
SOUTH KOREA**

Between the undersigned **LUIS ALEJANDRO FUNEME GONZALEZ**, identified with C.C. No. 79.938.937 issued in Bogotá, acting as legal representative of the **CITY OF TUNJA**, of the Republic of Colombia, and **MR. TAE - HOE YANG**, identified with document type No. 640726-1046124 acting as legal representative of **VISANG EDUCATION**, of the Republic of South Korea, this memorandum of understanding is signed based on the principle of equity, voluntary, and mutual benefit subject to the following:

CONSIDERATIONS

In order to promote international cooperation strategies and support educational strengthening initiatives in the city of Tunja, it is necessary to generate lines of cooperation that respond to the possibility of educational development with the learning of a second language.

In the framework of harmonious international cooperation, it is necessary to subscribe between the city of Tunja and Visang Education the present memorandum of understanding, which will be directed by the following:

CLAUSES

PRIMERA- OBJETO: Develop a memorandum of understanding as a cooperative relationship between the Mayor's Office of Tunja of the Republic of Colombia and Visang Education of the Republic of South Korea.

SECOND-COMMITMENTS OF THE PARTNER PARTIES

1. In accordance with the principle of mutual benefit, the two parties will seek cooperation to promote the implementation of policies, plans and programmes that foster the improvement of quality in the provision of educational services at the pre-school, primary and secondary education levels, through the pedagogical appropriation of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in the classroom, encouraging their assertive use, in order to strengthen the development of 21st Century competences in the educational community of the city of Tunja, with emphasis on the learning of a second language associated with the skills enhanced in the STEM approach.

2. Regular contacts will be maintained between the relevant areas and bodies of both parties to facilitate consultations on matters of mutual interest.

THIRD: STRATEGIC LINES

The parties hereby agree through this memorandum of understanding, the commitment to promote international cooperation strategies, and the provision of mechanisms within the framework of the following strategic lines:

1. Systematisation and exchange of innovative pedagogical experiences. This refers to the progressive incorporation in the city's educational establishments of disruptive methodologies and approaches and the monitoring of results, which allow for more efficient and relevant educational practices that should strengthen autonomous, critical, reflective, diverse and meaningful learning.

2. Relevant and innovative learning environments and resources. To create learning environments in educational institutions and the provision of educational media and resources in which the use of ICT is integrated in order to develop the potential and communicative skills in a second language and the 21st-century skills of the educational community of the city of Tunja.

3. Plan to promote the development of communicative competence in a second language. Contribute to the strengthening of pedagogical processes that lead to the improvement of the communicative competence in English of the children and young people of the official educational establishments in the municipality through the implementation of digital resources in the classroom and their use outside the classroom.

FOURTH-COMMISSIONERS

The parties will have commissioners who will represent each of them in the exercise of dialogue for cooperation, construction, development and follow-up of each established commitment. Likewise, the commissioners will be in charge of dynamising and guaranteeing each of the lines of cooperation.

On behalf of the Municipality of Tunja, the following will be appointed:

- José Alberto Moreno Villamil, Education Secretary
- Jaime Hernandez Suárez, Specialised Professional

On behalf of the Municipality of Visang Education, the following will be appointed

- Pastora Inés Gutiérrez Méndez, Commercial Agent in Colombia for Visang Education
- Yeo Jong-Ha, Team Leader Global Business & Strategy Dept. Visang Education

FIFTH- TERM: the term of this MOU is six (6) years from the date of signature.

Paragraph: the parties to the memorandum of understanding may extend the term for such period as they may agree or terminate it in advance.


SIXTH - GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION: The following shall be grounds for termination of this agreement:

- A. By expiry of the agreed term
- B. By mutual agreement between the parties
- C. Due to technical, administrative and/or legal impossibility to develop the object of the present memorandum of understanding.
- D. Due to an act of God or force majeure that makes the continuation of the MOU impossible.

SEVENTH: MODIFICATIONS, ADDITIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS: Any modifications, additions or clarifications to this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) must be made in writing by the legal representatives of each municipality.


EIGHTH: ENTRY INTO FORCE: The MOU enters into force on the date it is signed by both parties.
